

Bus Fares

- Bus fares on regional routes start at \$1.00 and increase depending on the length of your ride. Exact fares are shown below.
- Senior citizens (60 years and older or with a Medicare card) and people with a disability ID card ride for half-fare.
- Children five and younger, accompanied by an adult, ride free.
- Exact change is not necessary, but it will speed your ride.

Connections to Barnstable Municipal Airport ✚

- The Blue Line and Yellow Lines stop at the airport in Hyannis on request.

Meet the bus or shuttle at any designated stop or flag the driver to stop anywhere along the route.

Connections to Island Ferries

- Take the Red Line to the Steamship Authority docks in Hyannis for travel to Nantucket and Martha's Vineyard. Take the Red Line to the Hy-Line Cruises docks in Hyannis for travel to Nantucket and Martha's Vineyard.
- Use direct phone line at the Hyannis Transportation Center for free Steamship Authority shuttle to Hyannis ferry docks.
- Take the Blue Line to Steamship Authority docks in Woods Hole for travel to Martha's Vineyard.

Accessibility for Bicycles and People with Disabilities

- All Breeze vehicles are equipped with bikereaks. They are also accessible to people who use wheelchairs and to others with limited mobility.

Ride and Save

- Commuter passes at substantial savings are available from your driver, and at the Hyannis Transportation Center.
- Buy multi-ride bus passes at a 25% discount from drivers and also at the Hyannis Transportation Center.
